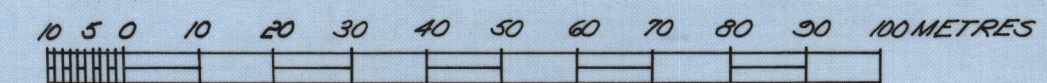

LEGEND

Bearings are derived from the Coordinate Control Monuments (FB 31539 CLSR) and are referred to the central meridian of U.T.M. Zone 8. (135° West)

Distances shown are horizontal at general ground level and are expressed in metres. To compute U.T.M. coordinates, distances have been converted to sea level and to the projection plane by applying a combined conversion factor of 0.99945. Bearings and distances have then been adjusted to fit the control.

All posts placed in the course of this survey are marked with appropriate lot number, the year of survey and 'R' for Road, where applicable.
